

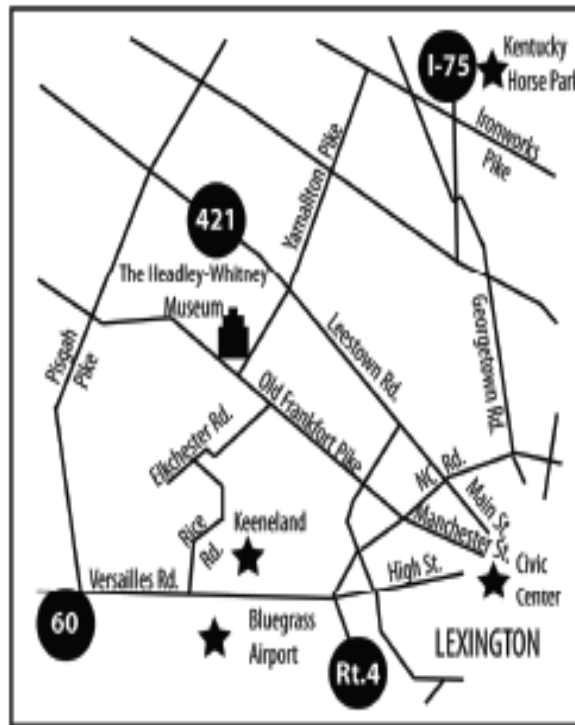
10. Head for the barn cross the circle, blacktop

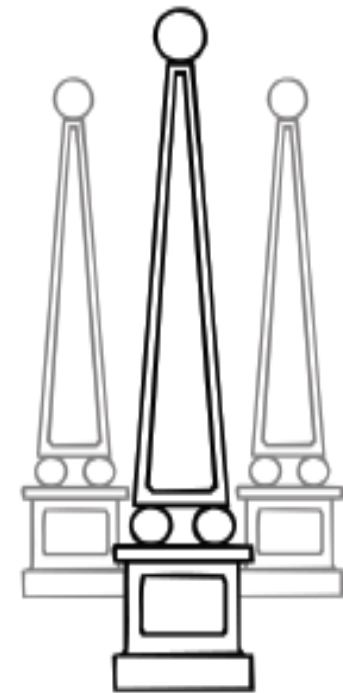

Start!
